Action Plan for quality initiative for student development for Academic Year 2018-19

**2.1 Innovation in Teaching Learning**

It was decided that Innovations in Teaching-Learning shall be continued with introduction of additional instructional strategies and ICT tools

**2.2 Creation of LCM**

It was decided that all faculty shall introduce Learner centric MOOC (LCM) activity. It is recommended to create 3 videos on courses taught by each faculty member using the recording studio and its equipment.

**2.3 Lifelong Learning through self learning**

Self learning ability of the students shall be nurtured by making them enroll for various courses available on MOOC platform

**2.4 Problem based/Project based learning**

It was recommended that

- Students shall be encouraged to use platforms such as Hacker Rank, Hacker Earth etc. for improving problem solving skills through programming
- To encourage UG and PG students to select Industry and societal relevance projects.
- Training on modern industry technologies should be introduced to students to embed them in their project.

**2.5 Employability Enhancement & Skill development****• Training**

It was recommended to conduct in house and out sourced training for students to enhance employability ability.



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- **Student Internship**

It is decided that efforts shall be taken to have paid internships for students and more focus on conversion of students' internship into placement

- **Placement**

It was decided that One hour everyday training for employability enhancement of students shall be imparted for all SE, TE, BE students

It was decided to have assessment of Learning Outcome & take corrective measures.

### **3.1 Faculty Qualification Upgradation**

It was recommended that faculty should upgrade their qualification & acquire doctorate degree.

### **3.2 Training for Faculty**

It was decided that all faculty members shall attend at least one FDP/Workshop/MOOC for upgradation.

### **3.3 Research & Development and Consultancy activities**

It was suggested that faculty shall generate funds through various govt/ non govt funding schemes of research projects, modernisation of laboratory etc., sponsored projects and consultancy.

It was also recommended that faculty should continue publishing their research work in reputed journals

### **3.4 Skill upgradation of Technical Staff**

It was decided that Spoken Tutorial shall be subscribed for training Technical Staff



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### 3.5 ICT training of faculty of non professional institutes

It was decided to organize ICT Training for faculties of nonprofessional institutes on their request.

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d. Encourage for research publication

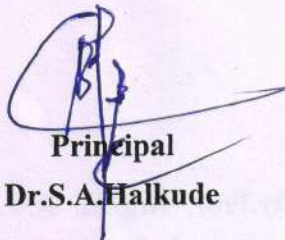
In the academic year 2017-18 faculty have published 175 research publications in various National, International journals & conferences.

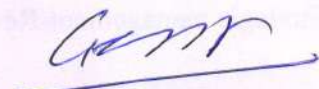
e. Campus training and placement to enhance employability skills

f. In the year 2017-18 60 companies visited for campus placement. Our 332 students have been placed.

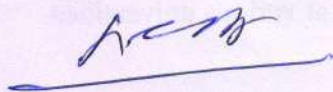
The meeting concluded with coordinator thanking all the members for their presence and active participation.

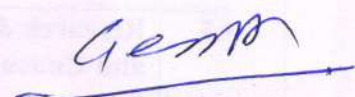
