### *Code of Ethics for Research*

The institute expects all the researchers to conform to the following points while carrying out the research:

- Each researcher must be able to demonstrate their contribution in the research /joint research and shall take full responsibility for the research.
- In all aspects of research, the contributions of formal collaborators and all others who have directly assisted or indirectly supported the research including research students, research staff, and professional services staff should be properly acknowledged with their permission.
- The Funding agencies of research (Government/Non-Government/Industry etc.) should be acknowledged.
- In the publications, the sequence in which authors are listed should be agreed upon by all authors.
- Intentional failure to acknowledge the contributions of others is regarded as unprofessional conduct, and instances other than minor omissions will be treated as research misconduct.
- Any person who has not made an intellectual, scholarly, or practical contribution, and has not participated in a substantial way in conceiving, executing, or interpreting at least part of the relevant research, should not be included as an author of the publication derived from that research. The so-called 'honorary authorship', is not encouraged.
- Research scholars must acknowledge and attribute all sources used in the research in line with their specific discipline citation and referencing convention.
- Researcher shall not submit substantially similar work to more than one publisher.
- The Research scholars should observe the conditions, if any, set by funding or other bodies regarding the publication of their research.

**Research Misconduct:**

Misconduct includes but is not limited to the following acts:

- **Plagiarism:** The deliberate copying of ideas, text, data, or other work (or any combination thereof) without due permission and acknowledgment. Plagiarism is "the appropriation of another person's ideas, processes, results, or words without giving appropriate credit". Representing any part or parts of another's work as one's own is considered plagiarism and may be a violation of the Principle of Ethics.
- **Piracy:** The deliberate exploitation of ideas from others without proper acknowledgment.
